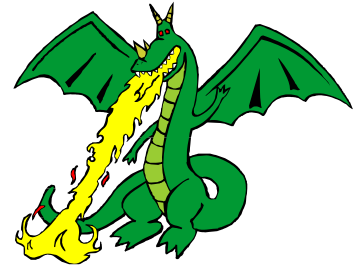

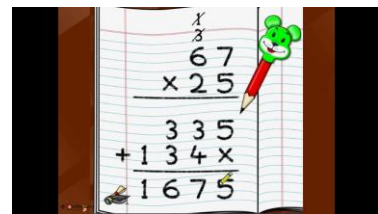

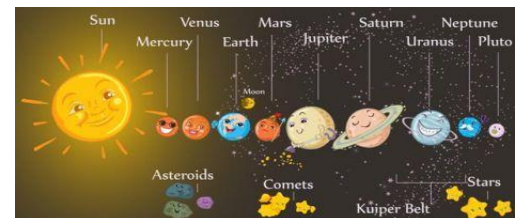
- ✓ Know your basic multiplication, division, addition, subtraction facts
