Dear Parents/Guardians:

Jasper Middle School will begin before and after school tutoring the week of October 2, 2017. During this time students can receive help on homework/classwork or any skills which are causing them difficulty. The students need to come to tutoring with something to work on. If a student comes with nothing to work on, he/she may be given an assignment on USA Test Prep or IXL. These are computer programs JMS uses for extra practice on the standards.

Morning tutoring for ELA and Math will be on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 7:30-8:20. To prevent interruptions during the tutoring sessions, it is recommended students get to school at 7:30 am when planning on attending morning tutoring. It will also allow more time for tutoring if the student has already eaten breakfast. However, if breakfast is needed, the student will be dismissed from tutoring at 8:00 am for breakfast

Afternoon tutoring will be on Mondays and Wednesdays from 3:45-5:15. Tutoring for all academic subjects will be available on these days. Students must be picked up by 5:15 in order to continue to participate in after school tutoring.

Tutoring is a privilege. This is an opportunity to stay on target with what is being taught in the classroom. Students will be expected to be on task and behave appropriately during these sessions. Students who do not behave appropriately will not be allowed to attend.
