Academic Updates

ELA - We are enjoying getting to know your students, and we are looking forward to a great school year! During the month of August, our ELA classes will begin by reviewing plot elements. We will be watching a series of Pixar short films and reading short stories to learn how to analyze the storyline in order to complete plot diagrams. This will prepare us for our choice reading and our class novels. Once we finish our review of plot elements, we will dive into our Informational Unit. Classes will be reading *Zane and the Hurricane* or *The Cay*, and we will be learning about the importance of credible sources in preparation for a short research project that will take place later on in the unit.

Mini lessons containing grammar and vocabulary will be incorporated throughout every unit.

Students are also encouraged to read their library books for at least 15 minutes daily.

Unit 1 will introduce students to the study of statistics by experiencing how to design simple experiments and collect data. The unit begins with identifying what constitutes a statistical question. Students can collect, analyze and display data through a number of graphical representations.
