Academic Updates

ELA - Sixth-grade students are reviewing all reading and writing units in preparation for the Milestones. Each week, we have been enhancing our skills in informational, narrative, and argumentative writing. Students will also be working on conventions such as pronouns, sentence types, and non-restrictive elements.

Students are responsible for ELA morning work. Many students complete this work during homeroom, but if students are unable, they should complete it at home.

<u>Please remember all students should aim to read for 20 minutes each weeknight.</u>

The importance of zero is emphasized in this exploration of numbers. There will be a focus on the concepts of opposites and absolute value, and how both are uniquely useful in ordering and graphing positive and negative numbers. Unit 8 will introduce students to graphing coordinates in all four quadrants of the coordinate plane.

Please remember that students have their spiral review to work on each night. Students receive the weekly review on Monday for the following week from their homeroom teacher. Many students are completing this during homeroom but please check with them to make sure it is completed before they come to school.

The spiral review is designed to review those skills that have been covered so students maintain an understanding throughout the school year.
