Pickens County School Nutrition will be serving meals as follows next week:

### When can I pick-up meals?

- Monday enough meals will be provided for Monday and Tuesday
- Wednesday enough meals will be provided for Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday

## Where can I pick-up meals?

 Meals can be picked-up <u>at all schools between 11:15 AM and Noon on Monday</u> and Wednesday only

Harmony – under the covered area where car riders are dropped off/picked up
Hill City – at the curb next to the kitchen/gym entrance before covered area
Tate – in the parking lot in front of the cafeteria building
Jasper Middle – at the back of the school near the media center, where buses
drop-off

Pickens Jr. High – at the bus drop off parking lot facing Refuge Road

Pickens High – at the loading dock are near the softball/baseball complex

- Meals can be picked up at <u>any of the 4 designated stops between 11:15 and Noon on</u>
   Monday and Wednesday only
  - ~ Hinton Milling (Hwy 53 West)
  - ~ Old Twin Tanks (Hwy 53 West & Henderson Mtn. Road)
  - ~ Mountainside Manor Apts (inside the gate at the park area)
  - ~ Foothills IGA (Hwy 53 East/Foothills Parkway)
- Any of the other stops listed on the attached document

**Do I have to pick-up at my child's school?** No, you can pick-up at any location

<u>Who can get meals?</u> Any child, 0-18, may have free meals. Children do not have to be with the adult picking-up meals.
