Academic Updates

ELA - Sixth-grade students are finishing the Argumentative Unit for Language Arts and beginning to review all of our writing units. Each week, we will be further enhancing our skills in informational, narrative, and argumentative writing. Students will also be working on conventions such as pronouns, sentence types, and non-restrictive elements.

Students are responsible for ELA morning work. Many students complete this work during homeroom, but if students are unable, they should complete it at home. Our morning work typically consists of a short passage and a few questions. Students also are reading a book of their choice. <u>Please remember all students should aim to read for 20 minutes each weeknight.</u>

In the upcoming unit 6, students will learn to use geometric and spatial reasoning to calculate the area of a triangle, quadrilateral, regular and irregular polygons by composing or decomposing into shapes, such as, but not limited to triangles, rectangles, trapezoids, rhombi, etc. presented within real-world, mathematical problems.

Please remember that students have their spiral review to work on each night. Students receive the weekly review on Monday for the following week from their homeroom teacher. Many students are completing this during homeroom but please check with them to make sure it is completed before they come to school.

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Finding Programs:


